JASPAL SINGH, J.

Through instant petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of petitioner for payment of arrears/higher grade pay after retirement in view of instructions dated 21.07.2015 (P-5) in compliance of order passed in CWP No.9169 of 1987 (P-4) and CWP No.876 of 1988, decided on 24.03.1994 (P-3) along with interest @ 18% p.a. And further directing respondent No.4 to send the case to respondent No.2 through respondent No.3 for payment of arrears/higher grade pay.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to

respondents to decide legal notice dated 16.06.2018 (P-6), duly served upon the respondents, in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice (P-6) and to take a conscious decision, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
