The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to take action on letters dated 18.05.2017 (Annexures P-12 and P-13) for according sanction to reconstruct the streets.

Learned State counsel has circulated a copy of Notification dated 16.7.2018, issued by the Government of Punjab, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat for conduct of general election of the Gram Panchayats. The same is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not controverted the submissions made by the learned State counsel.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has raised grievance of the residents, respondent No.2 is directed to examine the matter and take steps as per law.
