JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 15.04.2015 (P-1), vide which the request/claim of the petitioner for counting the service rendered by her in Punjab Women and Children Development and Welfar Corporation (for short 'PUNWAC') from 18.01.1985 to 19.12.1993 was rejected as well as for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the service rendered by her towards pensionary benefits.

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2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been pointed out by learned State counsel that the period w.e.f. 01.05.1988 to 20.12.1993, for which, the petitioner served the PUNWAC before joining the respondent-department, has already been allowed and to be counted for the purpose of pension as well as pensionary benefits vide order dated 15.03.2018.

3. In view of above order dated 15.03.2018 passed by the respondents, instant petition has rendered infructuous and disposed of as such. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court, in case, she feels aggrieved of the order dated 15.03.2018 passed by the respondents.
