The petitioner, while serving on the post of Lineman with PSPCL, suffered disciplinary proceedings, which resulted into the punishment order dated 28.03.2018, whereby his services were terminated.

The petitioner is stated to have filed a statutory appeal dated 30.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) before the Appellate Authority/respondent no.2.

The limited prayer is for direction to the Appellate Authority to decide the pending appeal in expeditious manner.

While issuing notice of motion, Mrs. Anu Chatrath Kapoor, Senior Advocate was directed to accept notice on behalf of PSPCL and seek instructions.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel appearing for respondent-PSPCL states that the statutory appeal shall be decided within next two months from today.
