DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The petitioners earlier approached this Court by way of filing C.W.P. No. 833 of 2018, wherein, following order was passed on 17.1.2018:-

“Without issuance of notice of motion, Mr. Rajesh Sheoran, Additional A.G., Haryana was asked to get instructions regarding listing of the appeal and the stay application. He submits that matter is likely to be listed for hearing as Division Bench has been constituted for hearing of the appeals.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, the petitioner is at liberty to raise all the pleas before the appellate authority.

Disposed of.

In case the petitioner is aggrieved with the order passed

by the appellate authority, he is at liberty to file a fresh petition.”

In pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner moved an application on 24.1.2018 but still the same has not been considered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that revision petitions are being heard on every Wednesday but because of holiday, the same is not likely to be heard on 31.1.2018. He further submits that in case the revision petition filed by the petitioner is not heard on some early date then the petitioners would suffer an irreparable loss and purpose of filing revision petition would be frustrated.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners for issuing directions to respondent No.1 to hear the pending revision petition on some actual date, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to hear the pending revision petition within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case for any sufficient reason, the revision petition is not being heard within two weeks then respondent No.1 is directed to hear the application for interim order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
