Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the action of the respondents for not releasing the leave encashment of 300 days, gratuity to the tune of ₹68,566/-, 3rd ACP scale, nursery bills amounting to ₹36,000/- (approx.) to him with further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature mandamus directing the respondents to release him the retiral benefits, which are unpaid along with interest @ 18% p.a.

2. File perused.

3. A perusal of the file transpires that petitioner has already served representation dated 17.01.2018 (P-5) upon the respondent No.5 but neither the respondent has responded to the aforesaid representation (P-5) nor taken any conscious decision. So in the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that instant petition can be conveniently disposed of by giving a direction to respondent No.5 to take a conscious decision within some stipulated period.

4. Accordingly, without expressing anything on merits but considering the inaction on the part of the respondents, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly to respondent No.5 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 17.01.2018 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved against any order passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
