The petitioner is widow of Mahavir Singh s/o Mange Ram, who was employed as Water Carrier with the respondents. He died on 27.07.2015. The petitioner sought compassionate assistance in view of the policy of the year 2006 but no order was passed upon her application. Prior to his death, husband of the petitioner and others similarly situated had sought regularization of their services through CWP No. 2326 of 2011. Learned Single Judge of this Court had granted relief sought for. The husband of the petitioner had moved a representation for implementation of the order of the learned Single Judge but his services were not regularized on the ground that the appeal is pending.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents fairly states that the Letters Patent Appeal filed by the respondents was dismissed and SLP against that has also been dismissed. Thus, husband of the petitioner is entitled to regularization in accordance with the judgment dated 20.05.2015 passed in CWP No. 2326 of 2011. Consequently, the petitioner would also be entitled to compassionate assistance in terms of the policy of the year 2006.

Since the legal position is no longer in dispute, the writ petition is allowed. It is directed that services of husband of the petitioner, be deemed to have been regularized in accordance with the judgment dated 20.05.2016, passed in CWP No. 2326 of 2011 and all consequential benefits arising therefrom be released in favour of the petitioner. Further, the case of the petitioner for grant of financial assistance, in terms of the policy of the year 2006, be also considered favourably and a speaking order in this regard be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
