By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to refix his pay and to revise his pension at par with Ramesh Chand – respondent No.5 with all consequential benefits along with interest.

2. File perused.

3. A close scrutiny of the file transpires that for claiming the relief sought through the instant petition, petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 20.02.2018 (P-9) upon the respondents and as per averments made in the petition, neither respondents have responded to the aforesaid legal notice (P-9) nor taken any conscious decision. So in the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that instant petition can be conveniently disposed of by giving a direction to the respondents to take a conscious decision in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, without expressing anything on merits but considering the inaction on the parts of the respondents, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 20.02.2018 (P-9) and take conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
