One of the grievance of the petitioner is that though he is entitled to the ownership of House No.1038, Sector 27-B, Chandigarh on the basis of alleged Will executed by his grand-father, but his other family members/relatives are issuing advertisement etc. to sell the said property.

In our considered view, the effective recourse for resolving such like property disputes is to approach the Civil Court including by way of an injunction suit. We have no reason to doubt that no sooner the petitioner approaches the appropriate forum, the learned Civil Court shall decide the dispute expeditiously ensuring that all persons who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the suit, are impleaded as party-respondents and are duly heard.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
