This order will dispose of the aforementioned two writ petitions, as the cause they espouse and the factual and legal issue involved is common and identical and, therefore, they can be conveniently decided by a single order.

At the very outset, Mr. K.K.Gupta, learned counsel representing the Board of School Education Haryana, concedes that the issue involved in these petitions is covered by the decision rendered in CWP No.26795 of 2016 titled 'Shikha Rani & another Vs. State of Haryana & others' and other connected cases on 25.10.2017, holding that no separate examination/paper

is held by the Board while conducting the HTET, specific to any language (whether it be English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Urdu or Punjabi) or even for Physical Education, Arts and Music.

Admittedly, the petitioner in CWP No.25907 of 2016 has passed HTET in Science & Mathematics, therefore, she is eligible for the post of TGT (English). In case, there is any objection, the Haryana Staff Selection Commission can examine the same.

As a result, both the petitions are disposed of in terms of Shikha Rani's case (supra). The Commission will consider the candidatures of the petitioners.
