Upon notice separate replies by way of affidavits on behalf of respondent nos.2 & 3 as well as respondent nos.1 & 4 have been filed in Court and it is stated that the salary of the petitioner has been released upto 31.10.2018 and same has also been received by the petitioner and as such the present petition has become infructuous.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes to the aforesaid factual submission.
