1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the notice dated 25.7.2018, Annexure P.6. A further prayer made is to quash the loan termination letter dated 31.3.2018, Annexure P.9, and also to the letter of foreclosure value dated 30.7.2018, Annexure P.7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
