The grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is that his request for issuance of 'Occupation Certificate' in respect of House No.72, Sector-5, Karnal has been declined on the ground that building was incomplete and the notice sent to the petitioner on the said address was received back with the remarks that he was not residing there. On the other hand, the petitioner claims that a part of the house is complete and he is entitled to seek 'Occupation Certificate'.

In the light of the categorical stand taken by the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Estate Officer, HUDA, Karnal, to depute a Junior Engineer or any other official who will inspect the house in presence of the petitioner and submit report whether the house is partially complete. If it is found that the petitioner is entitled to 'Occupation Certificate' as per Rules, the same shall be issued within two weeks from the date of inspection. The inspection shall be carried out within a period of two weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
