This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 29.11.2016 (Annexure P-21) passed by respondent No.2, forfeiting and invalidating 40 years of service as College-Superintendent.

Short reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. As per the reply, the matter has been reconsidered by the respondents and impugned order dated 29.11.2016 (Annexure P-21) passed by respondent No.2 has been withdrawn vide a letter No.8/3-2017 Grant 2 (6) dated 27.03.2017 (Annexure R-1) and the petitioner-College has been directed to complete the inquiry on the basis of report given by the Vigilance Bureau against Shakti Kumar Sobti, Office

Superintendent under intimation to respondent No.2. It has further been submitted that the petitioner-College is receiving regular grant under “95 % deficit grant-in-aid scheme”.

In this view of the matter, present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
