The land of the petitioners' predecessor-in-interest, measuring 10 bigha 6 biswa, situated within the revenue estate of Gurugram, as described in para Nos.3 & 4 of the writ petition, was acquired for the purpose of development of residential Sector-14 in the Urban Estate of Gurugram. The award was passed on 27.02.1973. The petitioners claim that regardless of the year of acquisition, they fall in the category of Oustees under the Policy formulated by the State of Haryana/HUDA and with a view to seek allotment of plot in terms of the Government Policy, they applied for allotment of plot on 29.07.2015 alongwith earnest money of Rs.50,000/-. It is averred that the petitioners have been pursuing their application but no decision has been taken so far.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any views on merits of their claim or entitlement, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to treat this writ petition as representation on behalf of the petitioners and decide their

above-mentioned claim by way of a reasoned order, within a period of four

months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
