The petitioner-bank is aggrieved by the action of respondent No.1 in respect of recovery of arrears of Provident Fund which were levied on second respondent. The action has been taken in purported exercise of statutory powers under the Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.

In our considered view, the factual issues sought to be raised in this writ petition can be effectively gone into by the Authorities including the Appellate Tribunal constituted under Section 7-D of the Act. The writ petition is thus disposed of relegating the petitioner-Bank to avail such alternative remedies.
