JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Jaspal Singh) is serving as 'Driver' with the Office of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Fatehgarh Sahib, since last more than ten (10) years. He is due to retire on attaining the age of superannuation w.e.f. 29.02.2020.

It was contended that in terms of the Transfer Policy 2018-19 (**Annexure P-1**), three options had not been afforded to the petitioner in terms of Clause-2 of the Policy, as he is covered under sub-Clause (v) of Clause-2 (a) of the said Policy.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 21.08.2018, had directed to maintain '*status quo*' regarding transfer of the petitioner.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel states that the impugned transfer order dated 16.07.2018 (**Annexure P-3**) has been cancelled, therefore, nothing more survives for adjudication in the present writ petition, and the same has become infructuous.
