AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing of the auction notice dated 8.8.2018, Annexure P.5, qua the property of the petitioner. A further writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to settle the loan account as the petitioner is ready to pay the reserved price fixed for the auction. A prayer is also made to restrain the respondent-Bank from auctioning the property.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to her, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to her, in accordance with law.
