JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner belongs to General Category and appeared in the PSTET-II 2017 test held in February 2018. He is stated to have secured 89 marks and thus declared “failed” as the prescribed passing marks for general category is 90.

Prayer in the present petition is for award of one grace mark for question no.112 of Social Studies Paper-II as the uploaded answer key for the said question is incorrect and thereby be declared as “pass”.

Upon notice an affidavit dated 09.10.2018 of Ms. Bimla, Evaluation Officer, O/o Director State Council for Educational Research and Training Punjab has been filed on behalf of respondent nos.1 & 2.

In the aforesaid affidavit it is submitted that before the

declaration of the result on 13.04.2018, grace marks to all the candidates including the petitioner had been granted against the aforesaid question no.112 of the Social Studies subject whereby petitioner has secured 89 instead of 88 marks.

Learned Counsel for the respondent-State submits that in view of the petitioner having already been granted the claimed grace marks and yet failed to secure the minimum pass marks of 90 in the general category, no further relief can be granted.

In view of the above, no case for interference is made out.
