JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Services of the petitioner while working in the local rank of ASI (substantively as Head Constable) were terminated vide order dated 14.07.2017 simpliciter on the basis of an FIR. However, on acceptance of the appeal, he was reinstated vide order dated 13.10.2017 (Annexure P-4). In the subsequent departmental inquiry, he stands exonerated vide order dated 07.04.2018 (Annexure P-6).

The grievance of the petitioner is that the local rank of ASI has not been restored.

Upon notice to the aforesaid limited extent, Ms.Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. A.G. Punjab, states that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed as vide order dated 29.8.2018, passed by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, the local rank of the petitioner along with other similarly situated employees has been restored.

In response, counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having rendered infructuous.
