Petitioner, who is 82 years old person, had approached this court with the grievance that order passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bhawanigarh directing eviction of son and daughter-in-law from the premises was not being implemented.

After notice of motion, a reply was filed by the State. Today the court has been informed that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. A copy thereof has been placed on record. It is stated before the court that petitioner has allowed respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to live in the house as long as they do not harass him and provide basic amenities.

In view of same, petition is hereby disposed of. SHO of the area shall, however, keep a general surveillance and enquire about the welfare of the petitioner. In case, he finds that there is a change of circumstances, he shall forthwith send a report to this court.
