JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner (Meenakshi) is serving as ETT Teacher and posted at Government Primary School, Attepur Block Dhar-II, District Pathankot. She is claiming the benefits of ACP and Annual increments stopped by the Department of Elementary Education on the false and frivolous complaint submitted by a fellow ETT Teacher-Suparna Saini (respondent no.4) posted in the same college.

It is claimed that three preliminary inquiries for various misconducts against the respondent no.4 have already been conducted and yet no action has been taken.

This Court had directed the learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab to verify the aforesaid facts.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel has filed a short affidavit dated 08.10.2018 of Sh. Kulwant Singh Wahla, District Education Officer (EE), Pathankot.

In the affidavit it is stated that the sanction order pertaining to the benefits of ACP as well as annual increments in favour of the petitioner have been issued. A chargesheet against the respondent no.4 for imposition of major penalty stands issued and she also stands transferred to GPS Anial Block Narot Jaimal Singh, Pathankot vide order dated 04.10.2018.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the respondents, counsel for the Petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
