AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This appeal has been filed against the award dated 18.06.2009 passed by the Commissioner under the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923 and subsequent order dated 03.02.2011 whereby the appellant-Insurance Company was foisted with @ 12% simple interest. Since the appeal is only on the limited ground of interest further detailed reference to the facts would not be required.

Learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company is not in a position to deny that in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court passed in ***Oriental Insurance Company Ltd. Vs. Siby George (2012) 12 SCC 540*** it has now been conclusively held that the insurance Company would be liable to pay the interest.

Consequently, the appeal is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
