The petitioner is presently lodged in District Jail, Faridabad to suffer 10 years' sentence, having been convicted on 11.12.2017 by the Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad. He has prayed for extension of parole on the ground that his wife has recently delivered a child, who is seven days old and is seriously ill. The petitioner was released on parole on 3.8.2018 and is to surrender on 25.8.2018. He has prayed that he has to look after his ailing wife and the small child, therefore, the period of parole may be extended for another three weeks. She has also submitted that the petitioner has not absconded from parole in the past. Due to paucity of time, counsel for the respondent-State was asked to verify about the averments made in the petition from the concerned quarters. Ms.Safia Gupta, AAG Haryana has informed orally that as per the information received, the child of the petitioner is an infant but about the health of his wife could not be verified.

Be that as it may, the fact that the petitioner's wife has recently

delivered a child, the parole granted to the petitioner upto 25.8.2018 is hereby extended for another three weeks subject to the bail bonds already furnished by him to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Faridabad/concerned Authority, the petitioner shall now surrender to the jail authorities on 14.9.2018.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
