The petitioner, who is 82-Years of age, has filed an appeal under Section 16 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') before the Maintenance Appellate Tribunal, Mahendergarh, Narnaul against the order dated 03.10.2017 by which, application filed for seeking maintenance, has been dismissed.

The only grievance of the petitioner is about the delay in disposal of the said appeal. According to the petitioner, seven months have passed but so far the said appeal is not making any headway for its decision. Thus, an innocuous prayer is made by the petitioner to issue direction to respondent No. 1- Maintenance Appellate Tribunal, who seized of the said appeal, to decide the same within a period of one month.

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In view of the prayer made in this case, I do not find any need to issue notice to the respondents and the petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1- Maintenance Appellate Tribunal, Mahendergarh, Narnaul, who is allegedly seized of the said appeal, to decide the same as early as possible but preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
