The petitioner has prayed for extension of his period of parole, already granted to him vide order dated 11.07.2018, on the ground that during the period of parole, he met with an accident and suffered severe injuries. In this regard, he has referred to the OPD Slip of Govt. Rajindra Hospital, Patiala, in which he has been advised bed rest for two weeks.

Notice in this case was issued yesterday for today.

Counsel for the State has submitted that even if the bed rest of two weeks has been advised, the period of one week has already expired and at the most, the petitioner can be granted extension for one week only though he has availed six weeks parole earlier.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner is granted extension in his period of parole, already granted to him vide order dated 11.07.2018, for another period of one week, i.e. from 25.08.2018 upto 31.08.2018 on the same surety bonds which he had already furnished, with a further direction that he shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 31.08.2018 at 5.00 pm.
