Petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for setting aside the checking report dated 20.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) issued by the Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam as also an assessment order dated 24.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Nigam. Further challenge has been laid to a compounding order dated 24.08.2016 (Annexure P-3), whereby an amount of Rs.30,000/- (Rs.15,000/- as theft of electricity and Rs.15,000/- towards compounding fee) has been directed.

Counsel at the very outset prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to avail alternate remedies as may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
