The petitioners are seeking benefit of regularization w.e.f. the date the Supreme Court has disposed of SLP No. 5230-31 of 2009 and 16389-16415 of 2009 and 18074-18094 of 2009 on 21.01.2013.

This argument is liable to be rejected. A perusal of the Supreme Court order dated 21.01.2013 shows that Joint Secretary to Government of Haryana has given an affidavit stating that the Government was ready to accommodate 258 candidates on humanitarian ground in the Industrial Training Department and the SLP was disposed of. This cannot be made ground to seek the benefit of regularization.
