The instant writ petition has been filed challenging the letter dated 11.04.2017 (P-12) issued by the Deputy General Manager (Estate), Punjab Mandi Board, regarding deposit of due amount towards allotment of SCF No.56 in Vegetable and Fruits Mandi, Jalandhar City.

Counsel for the respondent-Board has referred to an order dated 07.07.2014 passed by this Court in CWP No.25765 of 2013 (M/s Kasturi Lal & Sons and others versus State of Punjab and others) whereby it was observed that the allottees like petitioners have got an alternative remedy under Rule 12 of the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Sale and Transfer of Plots) Rules, 1999, to file appeal before the State Government.

In this view of the matter, the instant writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to file appeal within a period of one month from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. If such appeal is filed, no objection of limitation shall be taken by the respondents

passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of its filing.
