RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

The petitioners are aggrieved against the award of the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Bhiwani [for short 'the PLA'] dated 06.04.2017 on the issue of inadequacy of compensation. The petitioners include the widow and children of deceased Rajpal who died because of electrocution. The petitioners have been awarded a sum of ₹15,21,000/- towards compensation, ₹30,000/- towards funeral expenses and consortium besides the interest of 12% and ₹5500/- as litigation charges.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the amount of consortium is less.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusal of the record, am of the considered opinion that the compensation awarded by the PLA is quite just and adequate and thus it does not require any interference of this Court.

Dismissed.
