Petitioner is stated to be 43 years old and by filing the present writ petition is seeking a direction for appointing him as Constable on compassionate basis on account of the death of his brother Constable Ranjit Singh while on duty on 30.04.1991 while allegedly conducting an operation against the terrorists. Although it is not denied that one of the brother Santokh Singh was appointed as Constable on compassionate basis in lieu of death of Ranjit Singh.

It is not understandable under which Policy/Instructions petitioner can now claim a second appointment on compassionate basis and that to after a period of 28 years.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
