The prayer made in this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is seeking issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction for regularizing the possession and for grant of allotment of booth in question i.e. Booth No.39-A, Block E, Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar in view of the policies framed for 1984 Sikh Riot Victims.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently, certain relevant facts could not be incorporated and documents appended with the present writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh writ petition on the same cause of action by furnishing the better particulars.
