By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the salary from 01.01.2006 till 30.04.2012 and further revise the retiral benefits as per recommendations made by 5th pay commission along with interest thereof @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3-Secretary, Punjab State Social Welfare Board, Quiet Office No.16, Sector 35-A, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Secretary, Punjab State Social Welfare Board, Quiet Office No.16,

Sector 35-A, Chandigarh to consider and decide the legal notice dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
