Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing of notification dated 30.12.2015 (Annexure P-3), wherein no reservation in admission against the quota for children/grand children of terrorism and riots affected persons has been provided. The plea that is raised is that the impugned policy is not in consonance with the earlier reservation policies of the State Government.

The case pertains to the admission in the Post Graduate Medical Courses. As the notification pertains to the year 2015 and more than two years have already elapsed, prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
