Petitioner is an aspirant of admission to MBBS course for the current session against the seats reserved for NRI quota.

Respondent No.2 has filed its reply wherein in para 3 it has been asserted that petitioner never applied for NRI category and her merit was at Sr.No.374388 against 85% State quota seats.

In this view of the matter, it is contended that the petitioner has no case once she never staked her claim to the NRI quota seats.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the website

does not contain any such information.

Respondents have drawn our attention to the important dates given out on the website which clearly mentions dates for considering candidates against NRI seats. Therefore, the stand of the petitioner seems to be erroneous. In any eventuality, since the petitioner never applied for the NRI quota there would be no occasion for us to interfere, particularly, when the last date for the admission is already over with no flexibility even with the Courts to grant admissions beyond the cut off date.

Hence, instant petition is hereby dismissed.
