2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Bank or to take recourse to the alternative remedies as are available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him.
