By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the benefits of arrears of special increments, arrears of annual increment, allowances, GPF, step up increments and other statutory benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) states that as per the communication by the Treasury Officer addressed to Financial Adviser and Chief Accounts Officer, CAO, Ranjit Sagar Dam, the bills relating to the petitioners have already been submitted to the office of competent authority. The necessary approval has already been granted by the Punjab Government, vide letter No. 961337 dated 24.04.2017.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the records of certain petitions as reflected in the reply are not available with

the State to execute the Court orders.

Heard.

In view of the above, respondent No.3 is directed to pass the necessary order so that the funds are credited in the accounts of the petitioner(s). The petitioner(s) whose record is not available with the State, shall furnish complete details/particulars to the competent authority within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Respondent No.3 shall release the necessary benefits in favour of the petitioner(s) within four weeks thereafter.
