RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

The petitioner is the wife of Ranjeet Kumar, who is suffering 10 years sentence in a case registered vide FIR No.93 dated 12.8.2003 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 [for short 'the NDPS Act'] at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar. The appeal bearing CRA-S-1375-SB of 2005 filed against the order of conviction and sentence was dismissed. Ranjeet Kumar is on parole from 12.07.2018 to 24.08.2018 for 42 days. The petitioner has averred that during the period of parole, her husband Ranjeet Kumar has been diagnosed with Para Umbilical Hernia and has been operated on 14.08.2018. He remained in C.H.C. Kala Bakra, Hospital at Jalandhar from 13.8.2018 to 20.08.2018. She has prayed for extension of parole on the ground of follow up treatment.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after examining the record, am of the considered opinion that the surgery has already been performed on 14.8.2018 and the husband of the petitioner was discharged from the hospital on 20.8.2018 and has been merely called for

as the follow up treatment can be provided to him even in the jail hospital or through the jail authorities whenever required.

In view thereof, I do not find any reason to interfere in this petition and hence the same is hereby dismissed.
