AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has preferred a petition under Section 35 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984 read with Rule 28 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Rules, 1989, before the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana. Four dates i.e. 24.05.2018, 31.05.2018, 12.07.2018 and 26.07.2018 have been granted but even the preliminary hearing could not take place. Now the case is listed for 30.08.2018 and the petitioner is apprehensive that the case would be again adjourned by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, without there being any hearing in the case.

2. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or considering the same, in case the assertions made by the petitioner in the writ petition are correct, the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana-respondent No.1 would make an endeavour to hold a preliminary hearing on 30.08.2018 and if not possible on the said date, the next date of hearing which may be fixed by the said authority but in any case, not beyond the said date.

3. The present petition is disposed of with above observations.
