With the sincere efforts of learned counsel for the appellants, a settlement in this case has been arrived at. Learned counsel for respondent No. 4-ICICI Lombard General Insurance Co. Ltd. has gracefully accepted to grant ₹ 2,70,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Seventy Thousand only) over and above the amount granted by learned M.A.C.T. This amount is acceptable to appellant No. 2 and appellant No. 3 as full and final settlement. Learned counsels for both the parties have signed the settlement.

In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No.4-ICICI Lombard General Insurance Co. Ltd., to deposit two cheques or demand drafts for ₹ 90,000/- (Rupees Ninety Thousand only) in favour of appellant No. 2 and another cheque or demand draft for ₹ 1,80,000/- (Rupees One Lac Eighty Thousand only) in favour of appellant No. 3 with the office of Lok Adalat of the High Court. The payment as agreed to be paid to the appellants within a period of two months failing which the amount shall carry 9% interest per annum from the date of settlement.
