RAJIV NARAIN RAINA J.(Oral)

1. By way of this petition filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution, the petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to correct the name of petitioner's father in the mark-sheets and other documents as 'Ramesh Chand' instead of 'Ramesh Kumar'.
2. Today, CM No.15543 of 2018 for placing on record affidavit of petitioner Pardeep, is also listed for hearing. In the affidavit, the deponent has sworn and deposed as follows:

“1. That the above mentioned Civil Writ Petition is pending in this Hon'ble Court and is fixed for 12.10.2018.

2. That no civil or criminal liability has been incurred upon the father of the deponent i.e. Ramesh Chander (Correct name) neither in India nor in abroad with the name of 'Ramesh Kumar' or 'Ramesh Chander'.

3. That Ramesh Chander (Correct Name) and Ramesh Kumar (wrong name) is the same person as per record i.e. my father. Ramesh Chander was never named as Ramesh Kumar in his life. Ramesh Kumar was never my father and his name was wrongly/inadvertently entered in documents.”

3. In support of his case, the petitioner has also annexed photocopy of Aadhar Card of his father.

4. Accordingly, this petition and the application for placing on record are allowed. Respondent No.3-Board is directed to make necessary corrections in their record and issue fresh certificate/s to the petitioner after incorporating the correct father’s name within seven days on return of the old original certificates.

5. The Board while issuing fresh/corrected educational certificate/s will record in the certificates that *‘the correction in respect of father’s name is as per the orders of the Punjab & Haryana High Court in CWP No.23049 of 2017’*.
