Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release their arrears of leave encashment along-with interest @9% per annum from the date it became due till its actual realization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a joint representation was made to the respondents on 12.02.2018 (P-6) but till date neither any reply to the said representation has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide their representation dated 12.02.2018 (P-6) in a time bound manner.

4. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly to respondent No.5 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated 12.02.2018 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid representation as well as keeping in view the judgments passed by this Court in CWP No. 12179 of 2011, titled **Dr. K.L. Johar and others vs. State of Haryana and others** (P-1) as well as CWP No. 3732 of 2001, titled **Dr. Karan Singh Rathee and others vs. State of Haryana and others** (P-2) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. In case petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
