Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the stepping up pay at par with his juniors and also to grant him all the benefits i.e fixation of pay, increment, revision of pay scale, seniority etc with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (P-5) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the afore-said legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (P-5) in a time bound manner.

4. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. In case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
