The instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the balance amount for 1st and 2nd Running Bills for the work executed by the petitioner under Agreement No.16/2015-16.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that the entire amount of Rs.35,85,000/- stands paid to the petitioner as reflected in para No.3 of the reply filed in behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5. Further, the petitioner is not entitled to any interest as the work was not executed within the stipulated period.

In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered

infructuous and is dismissed as such.
