JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Two petitioners, namely, Amritbir Singh and Paramjit Kaur (petitioner Nos. 1 & 2 respectively) are the son and widow of late Surjit Singh, respectively.

It is averred that the aforesaid Surjit Singh had got injured during the terrorists' attack on 21.10.1990 and died in a road accident on 25.11.1994, while on duty as 'Head Constable', on account of which, his wife-Ms. Paramjit Kaur (petitioner No. 2) was recruited as Constable in the Punjab Police, Amritsar Rural, on compassionate ground, as her four children were minor at that time.

Now, petitioner No. 2 (wife) made a representation dated 16.09.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) to the Office of Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, to consider her son to be selected/appointed as special case.

By filing the present petition, petitioner No. 2 is seeking appointment of her son (petitioner No. 1) on compassionate basis or to

decide her representation dated 16.09.2016 **(P-1)** by passing a speaking order.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that there are some typographical errors in the petition, therefore, prays for permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

'Dismissed as withdrawn' with the liberty, as prayed for.
