JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the medical bills to the tune of Rs.11,44,772/- along with interest @ 12% p.a.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though legal notice dated 09.06.2018 (P-5) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any response has been received nor any benefit has been released. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent(s) to take a conscious decision upon the legal notice (P-5), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent(s) to consider the claim

of the petitioners as set up in legal notice (P-5) and to calculate and make the payment, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved against any of the order passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court as well as to have recourse to the other remedies available under law.
