JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to count past service rendered by him with Haryana Tanneries Ltd. from 05.05.1977 to 30.11.1988 for protection of pay, seniority, retiral benefits, pension and all other consequential service benefits.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide representation dated 16.01.2018 (P-9), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the claim of the petitioner put forth by him in representation (P-9) and to decide

the same in accordance with law, rules and instructions issued by Govt. of Haryana from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feel aggrieved against any of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court as well as to have recourse to the other remedies available under law.
