JASPAL SINGH, J

Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents No. 2 and 3 to grant family pension to him from July, 2013 and further directing the respondents to accept/entertain legal notice dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure P-1), within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Director, Higher Education, Shiksha Sadan, 1-B, Sector 5 Panchkula, Haryana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to take a conscious decision, in accordance with law, within

a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
