During the course of hearing, it is pointed out by learned counsel for the parties that sister of petitioner and respondent No.3, namely, Ranjan Minhas has filed a civil suit claiming her share in the estate of their deceased father. The civil suit is still pending in which the petitioner and respondent No.3 both are impleaded as party-defendants.

Since the controversy in this case also pertains to inheritance claim qua the estate of late Gurdev Singh Minhas, the writ petition is disposed of without expressing any views on merits, with liberty to the petitioner and respondent No.3 to raise their respective issues in the pending civil suit so that the possibility of contradictory orders is ruled out and Civil Court is able to resolve the matter by one compact order. This order shall have no bearing on the rights of Ms.Ranjan Minhas.
