This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 5 to take action against respondent No.6 for embezzlement of Panchayat Funds on the basis of Enquiry report dated 22.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) conducted by respondent No.7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.5-Deputy Commissioner, District Kurukshetra to consider and decide the representation dated 10.07.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sanjay K.Saini, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Learned State counsel states that he has no objection in case

prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5- Deputy Commissioner, District Kurukshetra to consider and decide the representation dated 10.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
